Requirements for the Thomas W. Holcomb, Sr. Scholarship

- I. Applicant must be a West Orange High School Student* of African-American, Caribbean-American and/or of African descent in his or her senior year.
- II. Scholarship applicants must be seeking or pursuing an undergraduate degree at an accredited college or university.
- III. Applicants must have a minimum 2.8 grade point average.
- IV. Applicants are required to submit a complete application which must include <u>all</u> of the following:
 - A. Two (2) typed letters of recommendation from non-family members addressed to the WOAHO Scholarship Committee:
 - One letter from WOHS (guidance counselor, teacher, coach, club advisor or other staff member); AND
 - <u>One</u> letter from a community service leader (organization representative or religious leader) verifying your hours of community service.
 - B. A copy of the most recent transcript and most recent report card.
 - C. One double spaced, typed essay of 300 500 words: (Pick one topic)
 - Please describe one event or person that has inspired you to achieve your goals and transform your life;
 - If there was one thing that you could do to improve your community what would it be and why;
 - State and explain your major career goals and objectives.
- V. <u>All completed scholarship applications and required items must be *postmarked no later than March 23, 2018* and mailed to:</u>
